Once on the EiE page, click on Nomination form and it will take you to the (Kaleidoscope platform) EiE nomination form. Scroll down and click “Begin”. Once the Nomination forms are complete, Kaleidoscope will send an Application link to all nominees to log in and complete the applications. These links will be sent on November 10th with a deadline of January 15th for submission.

International Dues Payment

International has asked that we pay our International dues (\$40) online. We are to sign in to our account on the alphadeltakappa.org site. Click on My Profile. Click on Pay Dues. You may pay by credit card or PayPal. Your transaction is secure.

PLEASE NOTE: You may still pay your International dues by check and send it in. The treasurer will no longer receive a H-138 but you can use the old one and circle all members who are paying or print out the chapter roster from the website directory. On the check memo, please be sure and have the sister’s name, MO and chapter name. *It might be easiest if your chapter treasurer collected all checks and mailed them to International in one envelope... remembering to include the sister’s ID and MO chapter name.*

- go to alphadeltakappa.org
- click on Sign In, upper right corner
- your Username is your last name followed with no spaces by your Alpha Delta Kappa ID number. That can be found on your KAPPAN address label
